Census 2010

At the time of publication of this City Notes, Etc., the City of Springboro's return rate for the 2010 U.S. Census was **77%**! This rate is well above national averages, but we need to get 100%! There are still forms being mailed out across the nation, so if you have not received your form yet and you want to make sure your information is taken, you can call the Census Bureau at 1-866-872-6868 and they can mail you another form or can take your information over the phone.

Beginning in May, they will be sending hundreds of thousands of census takers to every neighborhood in the country to count each housing unit that has not returned a census form. So, if you do not want a visit by a census taker, please make sure you return your form or provide your information to the Census Bureau.
