It is a “one-stop shop” that incorporates all the departments that are typically utilized by the citizens on a daily basis, a community room that can be used by community groups and an outdoor area that can be a staging area for festivals and small outdoor civic events.

CITY OFFICES CLOSED FOR MOVE TO NEW BUILDING
