



City Park Rules and Regulations

Park hours: April 1 through October 31 Dawn to Dusk
 November 1 through March 31 Dawn to Dusk

Pets:

- All pets must be on a leash no longer than eight feet and kept under control.
- Pets are not permitted to be tied to any trees, plants or other objects on park property.
- Pet owners will clean up after their pets or risk being denied future access to the park.

Tennis courts and basketball courts:

- Courts are to be used on a first come, first served basis and use shall be limited to one hour when others are waiting.
- Tennis courts shall be used for tennis only; except for the courts at North Park where pickleball is also permitted.

Prohibited in Springboro Parks:

- Camping, except upon written request approved in writing by the City Manager.
 - Playing or practicing golf.
 - Fireworks, illegal drugs, dangerous weapons or glass containers.
 - Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
 - Swimming, wading or fishing in park ponds.
 - No person shall hunt, trap or in any way capture, injure, abuse, or chase any type of wildlife.
 - No person shall remove or move within the park any natural or unnatural characteristic of the park (i.e. grass, stones, trees, flowers, signs, fixtures, etc.).
 - No person shall operate mechanical or electrical amplification devices carrying sound beyond boundaries of the park without written approval.
 - No person shall solicit funds or operate games of chance.
 - No person shall conduct commercial or personal enterprise on park property without first receiving written approval.
 - No person on park property shall recklessly cause inconvenience, annoyance or alarm to any other patron of the park.

- Athletic fields: Use shall be scheduled with the Parks Maintenance Supervisor or his/her designee depending on the field.
 - Trash, of any kind, must be kept in the proper receptacles.
 - Fires on park property shall be limited to grills, those provided in the park or personal grills brought to the park grounds. Grills are NOT PERMITTED under shelters.
 - Motor vehicles shall not be operated past the point provided for them or left in the park past hours of operation.
 - Bicycles are only permitted on areas designated for them.
 - Park use for other purposes than normal functions require written approval.
