GUIDELINES AND COVENANTS

- Trees are normally planted twice a year. (Spring and Fall at the City's convenience. Spring orders must be placed by March 15th and Fall orders by September 15th.)
- The program fee is \$300.00, which includes installation. Payment is due in full when the application is submitted.
- Tree care will be provided by the City. Tree replacement is guaranteed for five (5) years from time of planting. (Replacement trees, if needed, will be compatible to trees originally planted.)
- A laser engraved granite marker is included and will be placed near the base of the tree (See attached diagram.)
- All requests outside parameters detailed above will be reviewed and researched by the City and will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
